I took up the adult coloring hobby last year and was surprised as to how relaxing, interesting, and just plain FUN it can be. I started out with Dover's coloring books, and recently ventured out to see what Angie's books were like. They were more expensive than Dover, and smaller, BUT I have found that I absolutely love BLING! BLING is intricately designed, one-sided, and it has 50 pages. So you get quite a few "bangs" for your buck - or should I say blings! I don't use pencils - I use liquid felt tip markers, such as Crayola and CraZarts Supertips, and fine tipped Pentels. I've discovered that I tend to use the Pentels more than the Supertips on Angie's book because they lend themselves better to smaller, intricate designs. What makes these books fun is watching the designs come "alive" as color is applied. I have sat back and said "oh, now that's interesting..." more than a few times as I've been coloring BLING. I think if you enjoy coloring mandalas, you'd enjoy Angie's books. As a quirk of mine for coloring, I like to remove the cover (if the inside pages aren't perforated), and tear or cut off one page at a time to work on. Angie's books are nicely and professionally assembled with glue (really, they are VERY nice books, great for gifts), but I managed to easily remove the cover, which allows me to carefully tear off a page at a time to work on. Not exactly as good as having perforated pages, but not bad if one tears slowly. I am now a big fan of Angie's books, and in fact, I'm buying more! 6 of 6 people found the following review helpful.
