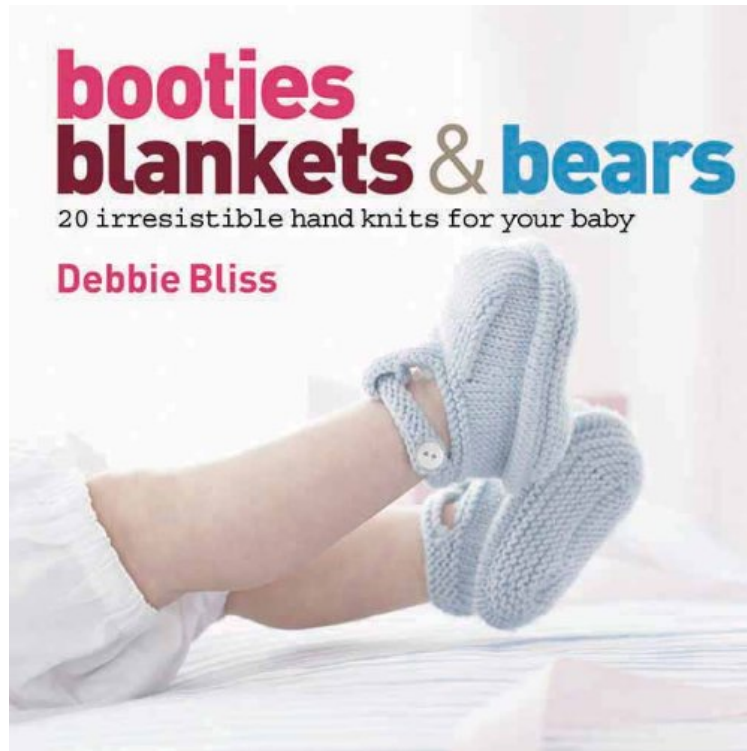

It's so miscounted, I mean HUGELY miscounted, I thought I MUST have an outdated copy... they surely have fixed such a huge amount of errors. I went to the Debbie Bliss website and looked in the revisions... sure enough they had a tab for the Booties Blankets, Bears book, I thought... ahhh now I can get on with knitting but when I clicked on the button, imagine my disappointment to NOT see any revisions on this pattern (I can't be the first to try it).I'm an experienced enough knitter that I was able to redo the pattern to work but it took a considerable amount of effort.Maybe it's a one off, it is the only pattern I've tried, but either way, I'm giving this book a one star for this pattern.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
