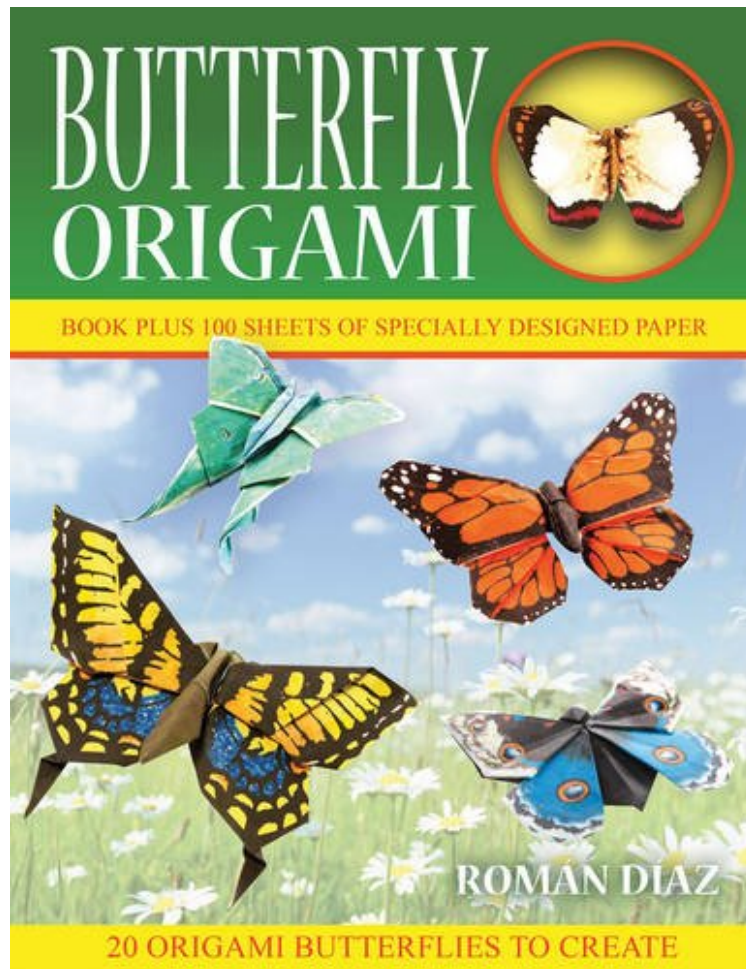

Can be difficult to figure out the folds, but the outcome is stunning. By Betsy The diagrams in this book were sometimes difficult to understand, I am experienced at origami, but I sometimes had difficulty figuring out what fold to make, and sometimes was confused about whether the diagram was showing before or after a fold. The models have a lot of steps (about 30 each). It's helpful to read through the symbols at the beginning of the book. It's also very important to make sure to orient the paper as shown in the initial diagram. For the variations, there is a small section after each model that shows how to orient the paper to make the variation. That said, once I figured out

what to do, the models were not that hard to fold, and each model was folded much faster after the first one. The paper is a bit thick, so that some of the bulkier folds are hard to fold, and sometimes the paper got a small insignificant rip when folding the very thick body. That said, if you take the time to figure out how to fold these, they turn out quite beautifully.

Fresh out of their chrysalis state, these beautiful origami butterflies will add color to any space, or can be used as a special touch on gift packages. Twenty widely recognized species flutter into existence when you follow the detailed, illustrated instructions. Specially designed paper makes these beauties realistic!
