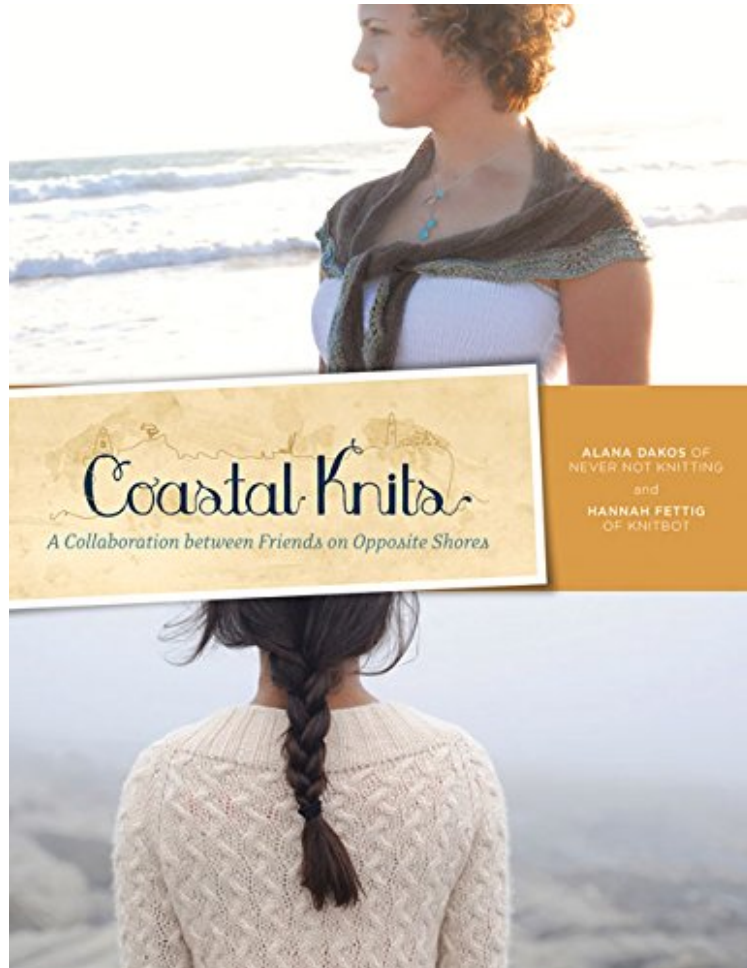

The nature photography that inspired the patterns is gorgeous, the patterns appear to be well written (proof is always in the knitting but they are very clear) and the charts a nice size so that when I copy the pattern from the book for a working copy, I won't have to enlarge the chart. Photos of the projects themselves are also clear. It's a lovely book to curl up with and read as well as containing so many lovely patterns. There are five sweaters, one pullover and four cardigans; there's a beret, a stole, a Cowl, mitts and a shawllette. There's a small section with techniques and abbreviations in the back. Although I have my favorites in the book, there isn't one that I wouldn't be happy to knit and wear, the patterns are that nice. I'm an intermediate knitter

although a bit of a neophyte with sweaters yet, and still, I feel that I could knit any one of these sweaters having intermediate skills and being new to Sweater making.
