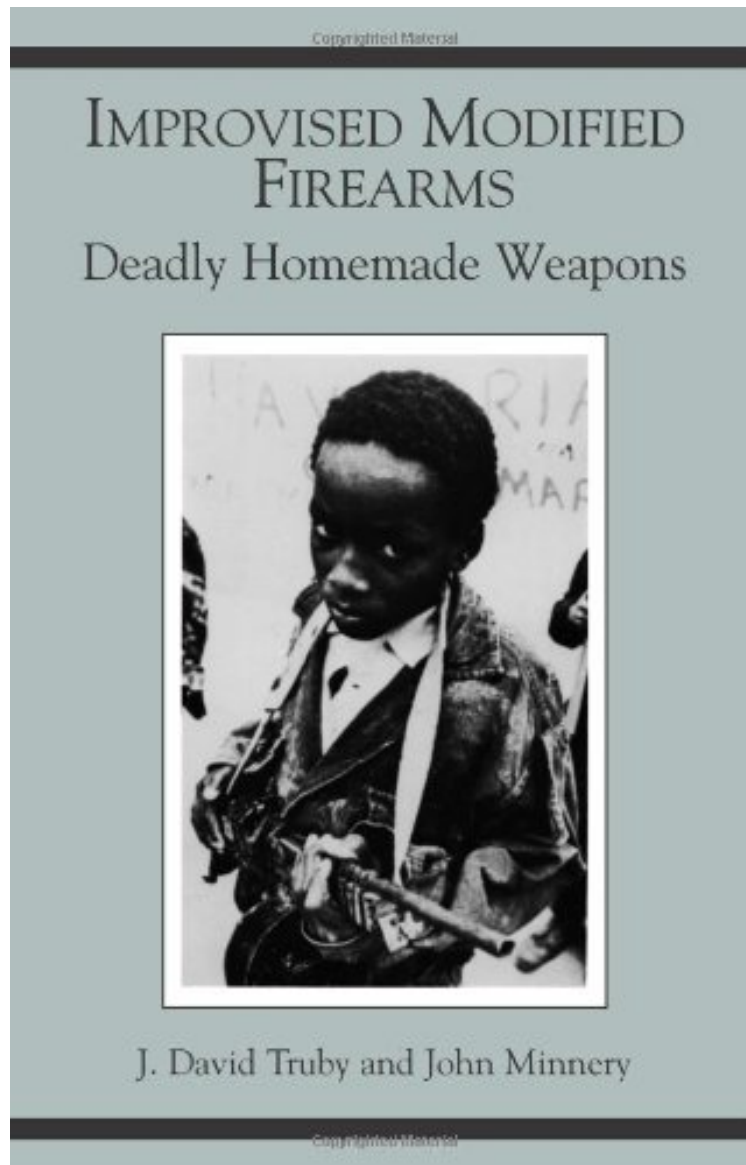

If you are into the study/design of very simple firearms, and how they easily be made from junk parts laying in your garage or from the local hardware store, then this book is for you. What was amazing was the designs of firearms/ammo made in prisons and jails. It's one thing to buy/read the CIA "Black Book" series, but this takes those designs to a whole new level and tells you how well they work and how unsafe some of these "piece togethers" are. This book has been in/out of print for many years- I was surprised that the original version was printed in 1970 or 1971- but the designs are still valid. I would recommend buying a copy while they are still laying around, since I would suspect that once purchased, they go into people's reference libraries, and are not resold. This book is not much larger than a common paperback book, but crammed full of small print and lots of BW photos of example firearms and ammo. The writing style is "classic" Truby, very easy to read, and lots of examples/interviews with folks that have actually handled and fired these improvised devices. You can't go wrong in buying this book. One last thing, this book shows that gun control does not work. If a prisoner at a state or federal prison can make their own firearms and ammo under the most watchful/supervised conditions imagined, and get away with it, you can just imagine what everyone else can come up with in their home shops or basements.

Take away free peoples firearms, and they will make others. Through vivid descriptions and rare photos, this book documents the extremes to which people including armies, gangs, guerrillas and prisoners will go when normal supplies of firearms are denied.
