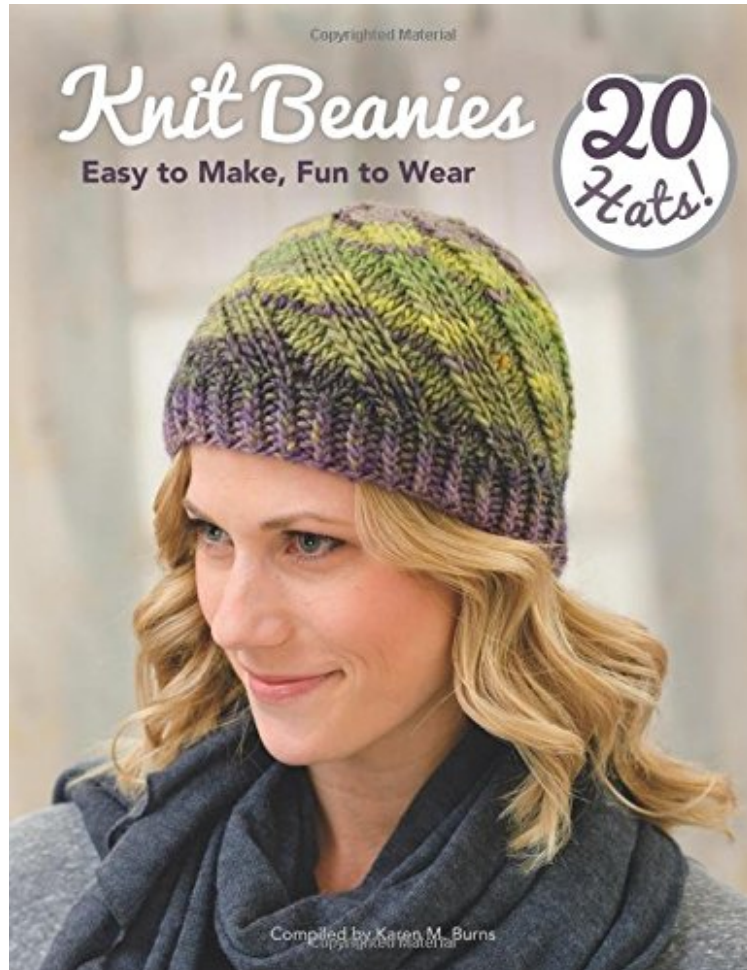

I especially like the fact that the patterns are written out and not charted - I.hate.charts.There are patterns in cable, garter, stockinette, multi-color and lace stitches. The author recommends several different types of yarn which I appreciate. Though some of the hats recommend acrylic yarn, which I don't use, it is easy enough to substitute wool.
