This is handy for me as a beginning knitter to keep nearby for reference. It has the most basic stitches and techniques-knit, purl, garter, stockinette, reverse stockinette, seed or moss, ribbing, yarn overs, twisted stitches, slipping stitches, a few increases and decreases, tips on gauge, joining new yarn, changing colors, picking up stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping back to fix mistakes. It has a small list of abbreviations, and a small ruler printed on two edges. It does not have techniques for casting on or off, though. It doesn't take up much space when folded and would probably easily fit into a project bag for people who like to knit on the go. It is 6 panels of super heavy paper or thin cardboard printed on both sides and laminated, put together like a pamphlet, so that you can easily have the page you are looking at on top while your hands are full of knitting. Much easier and quicker than looking things up in my big book and trying to keep it open at the right page while knitting, or looking it up online, especially when I think I know what I am doing and just want to make sure that I am proceeding correctly with the basic stuff. I have been asked to teach some family members how to knit, and I am going to give them one of these to help get them started. I do wish it included casting on and off, it would be a pretty complete guide to the most basic knitting on single point needles if it did. Very handy little guide for a beginner.
