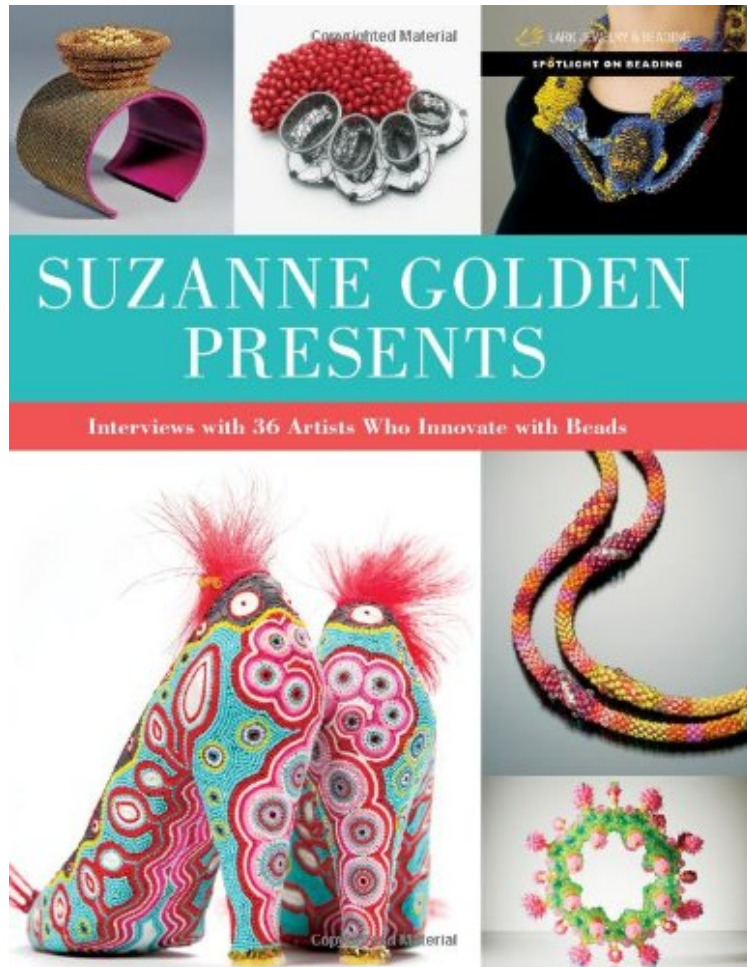

VarrasoThis book is amazing - Ms. Golden interviews 36 different beadwork artists about their motivation, mindset and techniques as they work with those little (usually) round things we all love so well. She picked the artists the way that I would probably pick them - when she saw a piece of their work, she was astounded, moved or just wanted to know how it was made. Most of the items aren't insanely pretty - but they all speak to you. I personally had a huge interest in Marina Dempster - the artist who creates the beaded shoes to evoke emotions. I was sad that the soles of the shoes

were beaded, therefore making them unwearable, but was definitely impressed with the messages she's sending with all the different shoes. There are so many other very, very talented artists - my original list included almost all of the 36 artists that Ms. Golden interviewed. The African Ladies who make beautiful and stirring items with beads and rags, or the woman who makes all of her beadwork in white, letting the shape and texture tell the story. I was even happy that the places where these people live was included, and especially proud to see that so many are from New England, where I live always lived. Douglas Johnson won me over the moment I saw his perfect woven tapestry of Fenway Park, the baseball field that all New Englanders consider ours. There are artists from very far away - Uliana Volkhovskaya lives in Dnepropetrovsk in the Ukraine, but her beaded sculptures of children's toys is as understandable and local as if she lived next door. If you are looking for patterns, or pretty jewelry to copy, this isn't the book. The items here are to think about, and perhaps use as a springboard to help you make your own beaded art, and the interviews are to help you get inside the heads of the artists who created these incomparable works of art. You might not love every piece, but you will love all the different stories, which are so similar to my emotions when beading (at times). I even appreciated the extra long, folded covers on the book, so you can use the cover flaps as a bookmark when you put this book down and come back to it again.
