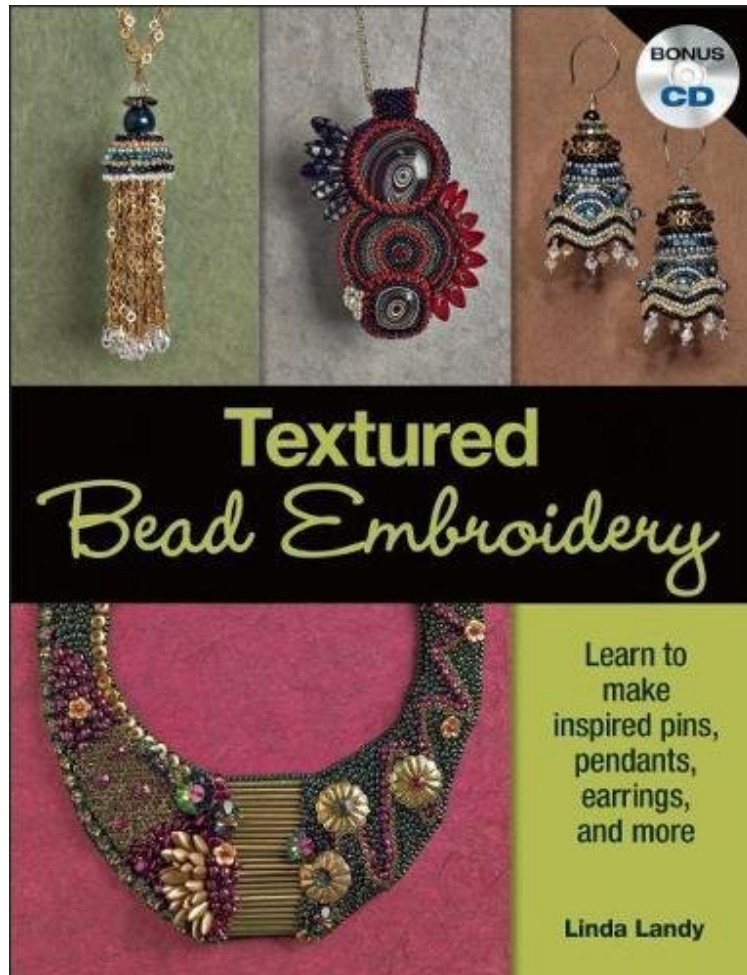

Author Linda Landy embraces the colors and shapes of all types of beads including cubes, drops, daggers, bugles, triangles, and more to create unique looks for beadwork. Beaders learn to make 12 creative textured projects ranging in size and complexity, including earrings, pendants, brooches, bracelets and cuffs, and neckpieces. A gallery of inspiration showing other texture possibilities completes this book. Also, this book includes a CD that contains six of the patterns from the book as an added bonus.
