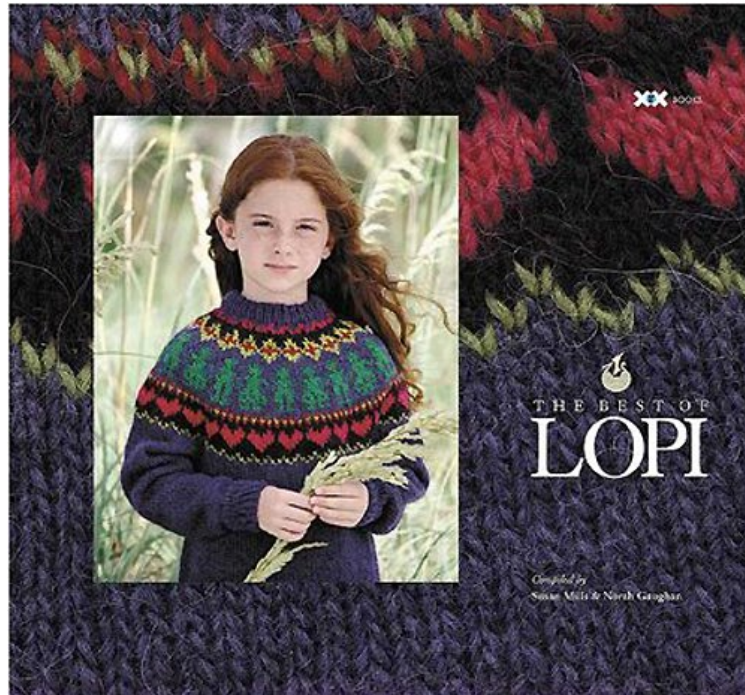

Since this will be my first adventure in multi-color knitting I don't want to worry about working the purl side, or reading charts in both directions.
